Show Rules & Information

1. Show held in accordance with ECHSA & VHSA Associate Program rules.
2. **Fees:** Classes and Warm ups are \$25 each. Divisions \$55 Pre-entry by noon Friday \$50/division & \$20/class. Please make checks payable to **ECETC**. Open checks are permitted for day of show. Return check fee: \$35. Stalls \$35 a day. Additional \$35 for each overnight.
3. **All horses must submit a negative Coggins! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
4. Six ribbons will be awarded to the top 6 placed competitors including Championship and Reserve in each division.
5. All ties will remain tied with ribbons and points shall be awarded accordingly; champion will be awarded to the one with the most points over fences.
6. The Judge's decision is final.
7. ASTM/SEI helmets must be worn properly when mounted, absolutely no exceptions
8. After 3 refusals, exhibitor is required to exit the ring.
9. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.
