*\*\*Maiden, Novice and Limit Equitation classes are open to riders that have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively competing in their flat or over fences equitation classes. Ribbons won in classes with less than six (6) entries do not affect a rider's status.*

**Conditions of Entry:** *Participants realize and accept the inherent risks, injuries & death due to equine activities. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Show Management but Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Show, Management, and the facility harmless for any loss or accident to his or her horse, horses, or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management, and their decision is final. Discourtesy to an official or show staff by any spectator, rider, trainer or groom will disqualify the horse or horses with which they are associated, and all fees will be forfeited.*
