



Open Schooling Show Series Division Descriptions

Baby Green Hunter Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. 2' fence height. Horse or pony must be in their first or second year of showing over fences. May not cross enter into any division above the 2' height. Simple changes permitted.

Beginner Jumping Equitation Division- Open to all riders not jumping higher than 18". Riders may ride horses or ponies. Four 18" (cross rails). Trotting fences is permitted. Simple changes are permitted.

High Hunter Division- Open to all riders. 3' fence height.

High Equitation Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. 2'6" height.

Junior Jackpot Derby- Open to juniors. To be eligible for the derby, riders must compete in at least one other qualifying over fences division at 2' or higher. To be judged 50% from way of going (Course A score) and 50% from handiness (Derby round score). Payout is 50% of total entry fees and sponsorship donation. Winner takes all. Riders may ride horses or ponies. Must have 4 or more entries. Can be combined with the Senior Jackpot Derby.

Junior Pony Hunter Division- Open to junior riders. Rider's choice of fence height 2' or 2'6".

Lead Line- Open to riders 10 and under. Judged on rider's equitation.

Limit Hunter Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. 2'3" fence height.

Low Equitation Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. 2' fence height. Minimum of 7 fences. Riders may not cross enter into divisions at the 18" height.

Low Hunter Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. 2' fence height.

Novice Equitation Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. Two 12" cross rails. May not cross enter into W/T/C divisions.

Open Adult W/T Equitation Division- Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Adult W/T/C Equitation Division- Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Adult W/T/C Pleasure Division- Open to adult riders age 18 and above. Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Baby Green GAYP Pleasure Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. Horse or pony must be in their first or second year of showing.

Open Buckaroo Walk-Only Equitation Division- First class judged tracking left at the walk. Second class judged reverse and tracking right at the walk. Third class to include two point position at the walk, halt, and line up. Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Buckaroo W/T Equitation Division- Open to riders ages 12 years and younger. Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Buckaroo W/T Pleasure Division- Open to riders ages 12 years and younger. Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Buckaroo W/T/C Equitation Division- Open to riders ages 12 years and younger. Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Buckaroo W/T/C Pleasure Division- Open to riders ages 12 years and younger. Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Junior W/T Equitation Division- Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Junior W/T/C Equitation Division- Riders may ride horses or ponies.

Open Junior W/T/C Pleasure Horse Division- Open to junior riders on horses.

Open Junior W/T/C Pleasure Pony Division- Open to junior riders on ponies.

Open W/T-1st year Equitation Division- Open to riders in their first full year of showing walk trot.

Open W/T-2nd year Equitation Division- Open to riders in their second full year of showing walk trot.

Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter Division- Open to juniors and adult amateurs only. 2' fence height.

Pre-Jumping Equitation Division- Open to all riders not competing over fences. Riders may ride horses or ponies. Four trot poles.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation Division- Open to riders ages 12 and under, not jumping higher than 18". Riders may ride horses or ponies. Four 18" (cross rails). Trotting fences is permitted. Simple changes are permitted.

Schooling Hunter Division- Open to all riders. Riders may ride horses or ponies. 2'6" fence height.

Senior Jackpot Derby- Open to riders ages 18 and up. To be eligible for the derby, riders must compete in at least one other qualifying over fences division at 2' or higher. To be judged 50% from way of going (Course A score) and 50% from handiness (Derby round score). Payout is 50% of total entry fees and sponsorship donation. Winner takes all. Riders may ride horses or ponies. Must have 4 or more entries. Can be combined with the Junior Jackpot Derby.

Student Equitation Division- Open to all riders not jumping higher than 18". Riders may ride horses or ponies. 18" fence height. Minimum of 7 fences. Trotting fences is permitted. Simple changes are permitted.
